That was the expression that got stuck with me when I was waiting for an assignment to serve our great Archdiocese of Newark. After 14 years of being away, living a missionary life as a Catholic chaplain in the United States Air Force, it was time to return HOME! Let me tell you a little bit about myself. My name is Rev. Oscar Daniel Fonseca, 60 years old, born and raised in Bayamon, PR. I first went to college out of high school to be a Physical Therapist. I moved to New York City at age 22 and worked at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Manhattan, NY. A few years later, I decided to join the Augustinian Seminary in PR. After one year of formation, I realized I was not ready to commit as a religious order priest so I left seeking to live in the United States Air Force as a Physical Therapist. Life in the military was amazing, exposed to many unique cultures and meeting interesting people from all over the world. My call to the priesthood was really born after I was sent to Turkey. I visited so many holy places there, places that spoke clearly to me that God was choosing me to follow him. So I did, I was accepted at the Immaculate Conception Seminary, Seton Hall University, where I completed all my formation and studies there. How wonderful the 5 years of my life I lived there! My deep desire to serve God's people intensified as I surrendered more and more to God's will. The happiest day of my life came when I received the gift of the priesthood of Jesus Christ on the 26th of May 2007. From that moment on, my life took a different turn to service to God and His people. I was assigned to serve at the Sacred Heart Cathedral Basilica in Newark for just a year and few months. Although it was a short assignment, I was delighted with the faith and devotion of the small community there. The Lord had a new plan for me as I was sent to serve the people of this great community of St Joseph of the Palisades, West New York, NJ in 2008. I will always be in debt with this great community because I was truly formed a priest here, the rich and invaluable experience received here no words cannot describe. After 4 years serving here, the Lord had another plan for me: to serve his people in military uniform. I served for 13 years as a chaplain in foreign places such as Japan, Korea, Saudi Arabia, Katar which fortified my priestly vocation and commitment to continue serving God and his people. But the Lord didn't end with me yet, now, he is placing me to serve my dearest community of St Joseph of the Palisades again. This time as their Pastor, a huge responsibility that I will embrace thoroughly with all the strength of my heart. "No greater love than to lay down your life for a friend" I promise to live by these words today and forever. I trust in the support of this faithful and devout community, the staff and brother priests to accomplish the task assigned. May God continue blessing this amazing community abundantly.

Father Ricardo Padilla

My name is Ricardo Padilla. I am 35 years old and was born in Turlock, California, where my family has lived since my childhood. I am one of five children; my parents and older siblings were born in Mexico, while my younger sister and I were born in California. My life was shaped by my family, my community, and the agricultural region where I grew up.

Growing up among orchards, fields, and harvests taught me patience, hard work, and dependence on God's providence. The beauty of nearby Yosemite, along with the diversity of farmers, cowboys, families, rodeos, and local traditions, helped form who I am.

As a young man, I worked in my family's used-car business, beginning as a car detailer and later becoming a salesperson and manager. This work taught me responsibility, discipline, perseverance, communication, and honest service.

I studied at California State University, Stanislaus, with the hope of becoming a physical therapist and the first in my family to earn a doctoral degree. Yet near the end of my studies, I began to feel God's call, formed through my family's participation in the Neocatechumenal Way at St. Anthony's Catholic Church in Hughson, California.

In 2017, I left behind family, friends, studies, and work, willing to go wherever the Lord desired to send me. By God's providence, I was brought to the Redemptoris Mater Seminary of the Archdiocese of Newark, New Jersey, where for almost ten years the Lord formed my heart, strengthened my vocation, and prepared me for priesthood.

Looking back, I see that my life has been guided by grace. Through my family, work, studies, parish, and the prayers of many people, the Lord used every part of my story to make me the priest I am today. For all of this, I give thanks to God.
